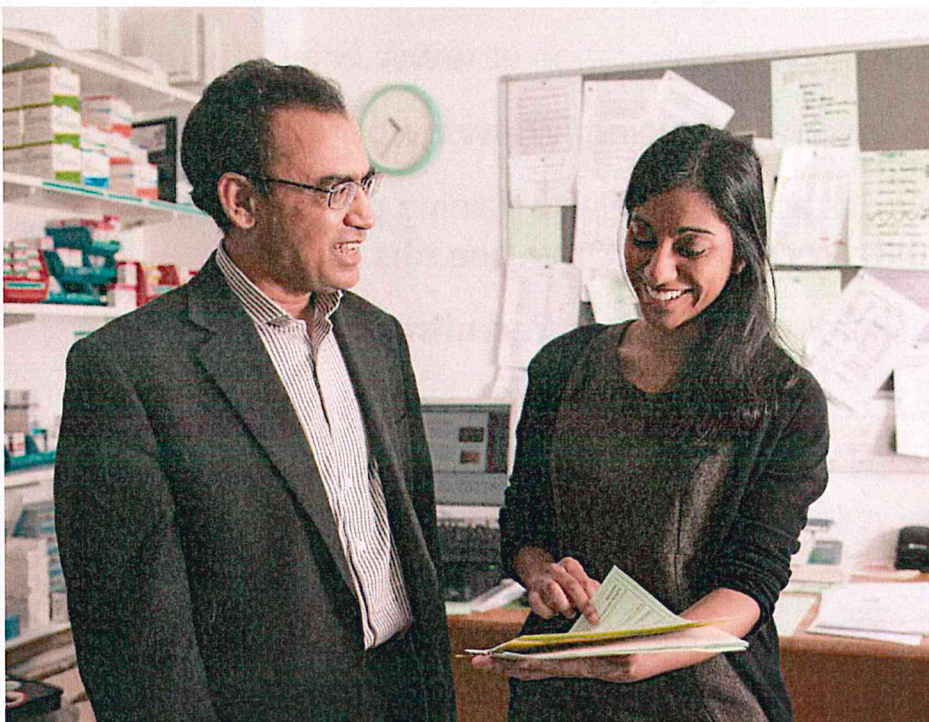


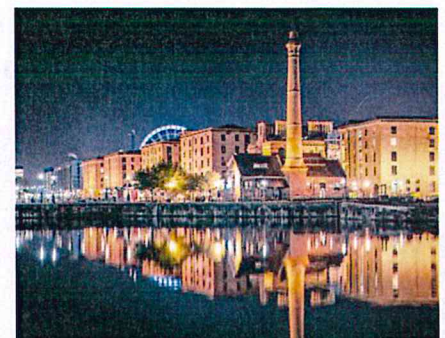

Current training opportunities for Junior Doctors in England

There are currently training opportunities for junior doctors in England, particularly in General Practice (GP) and Psychiatry.

Timetable

- Recruitment opens on **August 9th 2016** and closes on **August 25th 2016** for jobs starting in February 2017
- Applicants for GP or Psychiatry will be asked to sit an online test (SRA test) between **September 10th – 13th 2016**
- Interviews will take place for GP and Psychiatry during **September 2016** – dates to be confirmed.
- Jobs will start in England on **February 1st 2017**.

IELTs

- Doctors who have not trained in the UK have to demonstrate they have the required level of English. This is usually done by getting Academic IELTS level 7.5 with at least at level 7 in every area of the test.
